Parent(s) Certification of Student's Dependent Status for Federal Income Tax Purposes

(For Parental Access to Student Information Without a Release from the Student)

According to federal law, once a student enrolls in an institution of higher education, whether the student is over age 18 or not, the student's parents no longer have automatic access to the student's education records. However, if the parents claim the student as a dependent on their federal income tax return, they may have access to the student's UNC-Chapel Hill education records without the student's prior written consent. If either parent claims the student, then both parents have access to the student's education records. Because tax dependency can change from year to year, parents who wish to establish eligibility to receive information from their students' education records must furnish the following information each year.
