(Dropping all classes requires a term withdrawal and follows the withdrawal and prorated refund policy.)</p> <p><u>Undergraduate Degree Applications for May 2020 Close 5PM:</u> Last day for undergraduate students to submit a May 2020 degree application in ConnectCarolina.</p>	
<p><u>Undergraduate Class Drop (On Record) Period Begins:</u> Undergraduate students can drop classes in ConnectCarolina. The class remains on the student record with a withdrawal grade notation (“W”). Full-time students must maintain a minimum of 12 credit hours.</p>	<p>Thursday, January 23</p>
