

Enrollment Confirmation Frequently Asked Questions

1) Why do I have to confirm my enrollment and the UNC Honor Code each term?

Keeping track of which students have begun coursework and accepted the Honor Code will help the University:

- Ensure that students are aware of their responsibilities regarding academic integrity.
- Increase the overall fairness and value of the University's teaching, learning, research, or public service activities.
- Administer financial aid within the regulations established by the Department of Education.

2) When do I need to do this?

You should begin acknowledging your academic activity as soon as you participate in your classes each term. You may update each course in ConnectCarolina between the first meeting of the course and the add/drop deadline for the term.

3) What does academic activity mean?

Academically related activities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Physically attending a class;
- Submitting an academic assignment;
- Taking an exam, completing an interactive tutorial, or participating in computer-assisted instruction;
- Attending a study group that is assigned by the professor or staff for a course;
- Actively participating in an online course discussion about academic matters.

Living in on-campus housing, participating in a meal plan, participating in academic advising or counseling, and logging into an online class without participating do not constitute academic activity.

4) What if my schedule changes or I am planning to drop a course?

You will be able to return to the Enrollment Confirmation screen throughout the add/drop period to confirm academic activity in any classes you add after you have already submitted the confirmation. If you are planning to drop a course, you should still confirm activity if you have participated in the class. You must also go to ConnectCarolina to drop the course.

5) If I don't confirm activity, will I be dropped from a course?

No, the information you enter in the Enrollment Confirmation page will not affect your actual course enrollment. If you want to drop a course, you must do so in ConnectCarolina.

6) What if I do not plan to attend the University this term?

If you do not plan to attend the upcoming or current term, you should follow the instructions to submit a request to cancel your registration or withdraw from the University Registrar here: https://registrar.unc.edu/academic-services/withdrawals-cancellations/


7) What happens if I don't complete the confirmation?

Not completing the confirmation could have serious consequences, including the inability to register for a subsequent term or the reduction or loss of financial aid awards. You are encouraged to participate as early as possible.

- 8) How do I confirm my enrollment?
 - a. As soon as you begin to participate in your classes each term, log into ConnectCarolina.
